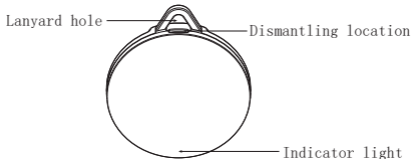

3. Instructions for Use

1、 Pull out the battery insulator to power the device on immediately.



2、 Contact your sales company to download the official device management APP. To bind the device for management, ensure your smartphone's Bluetooth is turned on and place the device near your phone. This proximity ensures a quick and successful binding process.

⚠ WARNING

- **INGESTION HAZARD:** This product contains a button cell or coin battery.
- **DEATH** or serious injury can occur if ingested.
- A swallowed button cell or coin battery can cause **Internal Chemical Burns** in as little as **2 hours**.
- **KEEP** new and used batteries **OUT OF REACH** of **CHILDREN**
- **Seek immediate medical attention** if a battery is suspected to be swallowed or inserted inside any part of the body.



- Remove and immediately recycle or dispose of used batteries according to local regulations, and keep away from children and animals. Do NOT dispose of batteries in household rubbish or incinerate.

- Use a CR2032 battery (nominal voltage: 3V).

- Ensure that the batteries are installed correctly according to polarity (+ and -).

5. Important Reminder

- 1、 Battery life time varies depending on individual usage habits. Frequent audible searching will accelerate the consumption of the battery.
- 2、 In order to ensure better dustproof and waterproof, after installation, please be sure to press the upper and lower covers to ensure that the equipment is sealed.
- 3、 Because the device adopts crowdsourcing network, there may be a delay in positioning, such as the management platform and APP no data, you can wait for half an hour to refresh the location information. And try to open the device in the place where there are more cell phones.
- 4、 Please do not disassemble the device, improper handling by non-professionals may cause damage to the device.
- 5、 The product may present a choking hazard to small children and animals

5. FAQ

1、 How to confirm that the device has been turned on?
There will be a buzzer reminder after powering on, accompanied by flashing LEDs.

2、 How to turn off the device?

The device has low power consumption and can not be shut down, if you need to shut down the device, you need to pull out the battery.

6. Use and care

1、 Don't use your product in temperatures below -20°C or above 45°C . Don't store/transport your product in temperatures below -20°C or above 70°C .

2、 Don't drop, disassemble, puncture, crush or expose your product to fire.

3、 To clean your product, use a dry, soft cloth.
